

Green Pastures International School is a private school established in 2000 to provide children in the neighboring areas descent schooling. Free from the problems of overflowing classrooms and exceedingly low teacher to pupil ratio, Green Pastures child focused approach is one which should pave the way for new schools to come.

Built on a collectivist non-profit ethos, monies collected from tuition fees are immediately pumped back into the school itself, paying for the Teachers wages and also the maintenance of the school. Sympathetic to the incomes of Parents and remaining true to its spirit, Green Pastures boasts one of the lowest levels of fee tuition; yet one of the highest in academic laurels; in the surrounding local area.

New in age, the school has already nurtured and developed some remarkably bright students who may not have been given the attention they deserved had they attended one of the overrun State schools.

Late and even more commonly non-payment of tuition fees has meant that the school, especially during periods of difficulty, has not been able to pay their members of staff on time. Burdened with possibility of having to 'sack' those students failing to make tuition fee payments, Green Pastures has asked us to help them in their plight to continue offering schooling to those that are most in need.

When I grow up I want to be a police man. I am in class 2. The subjects that I like are Maths, R.M.E."

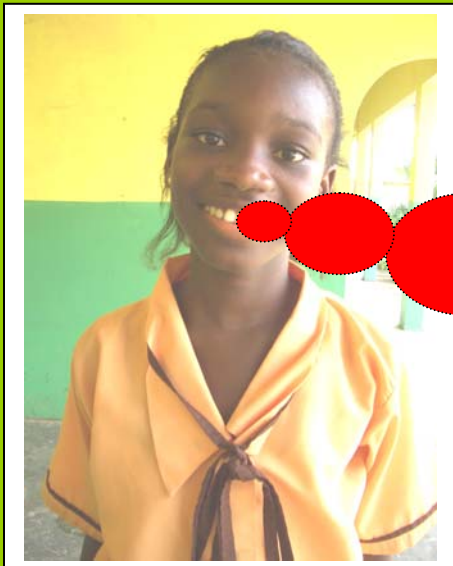


"**Priscilla Lartey** is my name. I am 11 years of age. I live at Awoshie and come from Kwabenya in the greater Accra Region of Ghana.

Newscaster is my chosen ambition in the future and in school my best subject is English because of my chosen ambition. I want to become a newscaster so that people will hear what is going on around them.

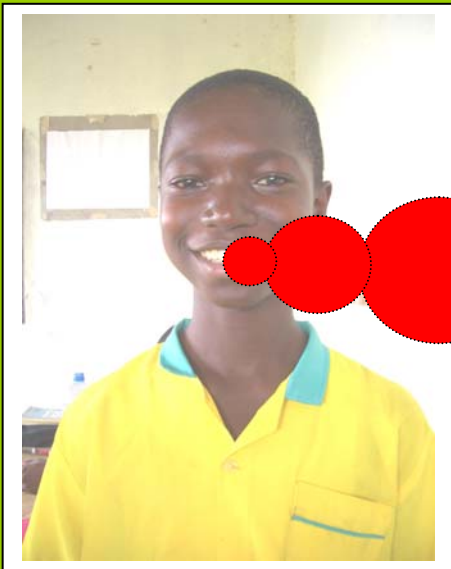
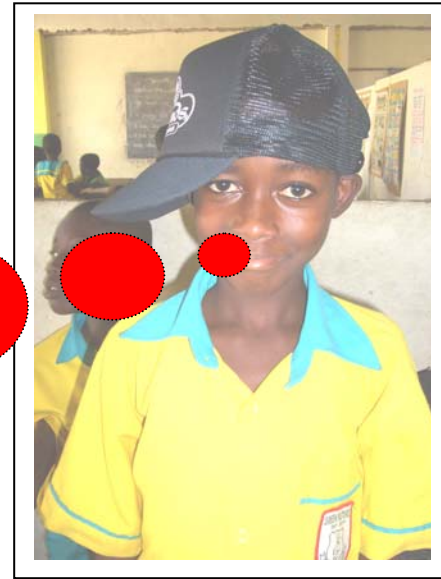
I would like to go on tour to an English speaking country preferably England."

"My name is **Ebenezer Adu Twum**, I come from Dunkwa in the Ashanti Region. I am 12 years old. I am dark in complexion.

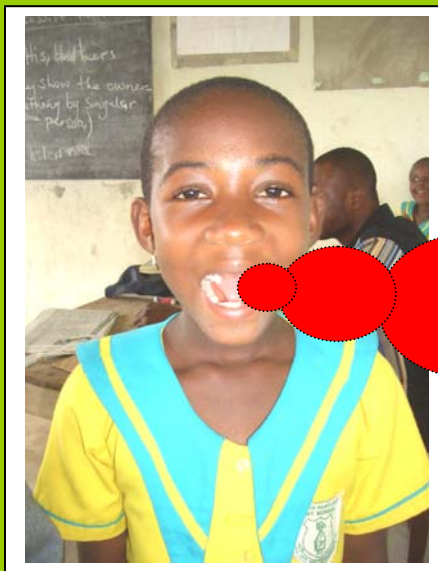
The subject I like best is Maths, English and RME. I want to be a football player in the future. I love football very much because football is a very good sport. I want to live in the United States of America.

## What we plan to do:

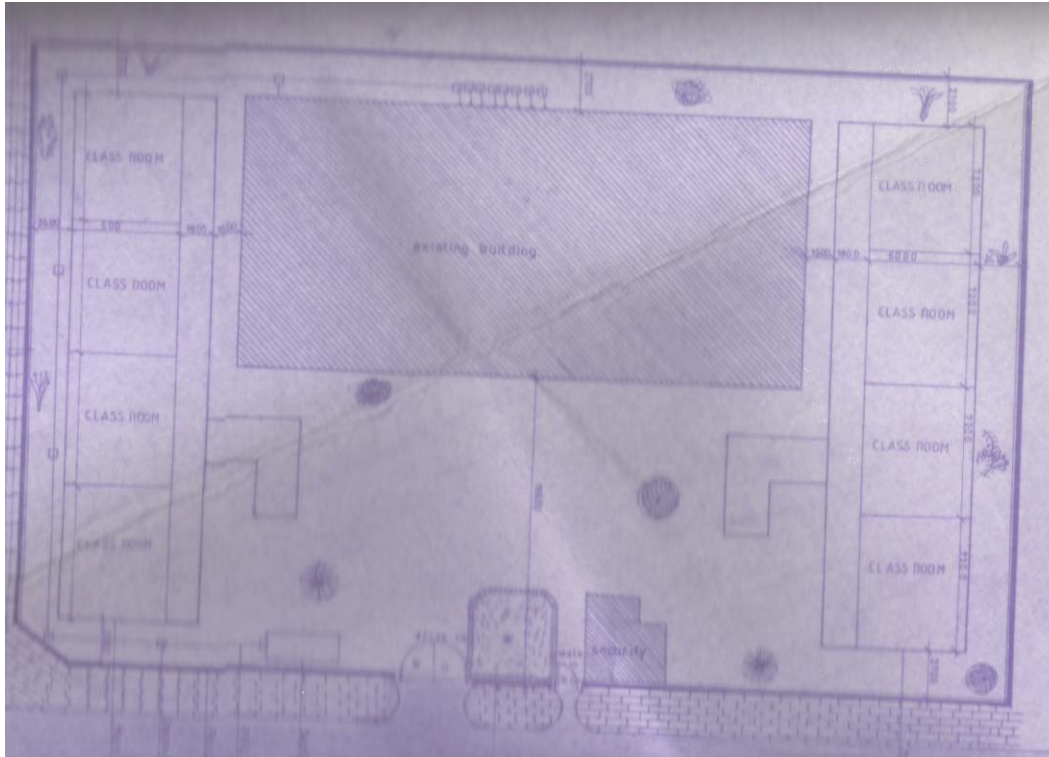
- 1. Build a Junior Secondary School (J.S.S)**

**6. Fit windows into all the classrooms.**

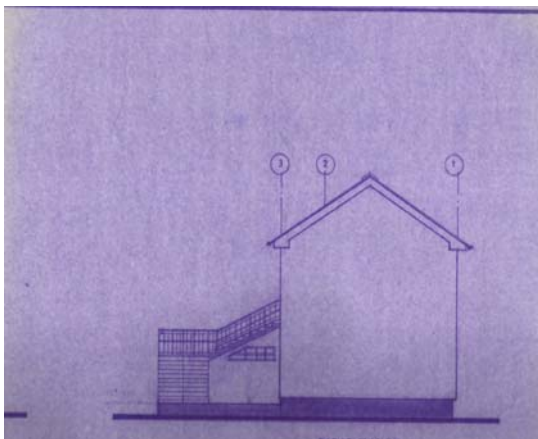
Currently none of the classrooms have windows which has caused huge disruption during the rainy seasons.
